## Homework

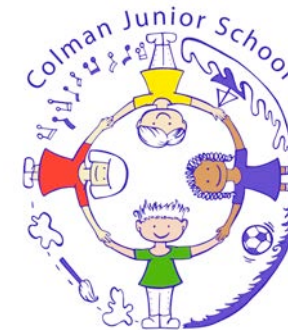
