Homework

In Year 6 children are expected to spend 2 hours a week on homework tasks. This will consist of 30 minutes Maths and 30 minutes English every week. English and Maths homework will be given out on a Thursday and should be handed in on Monday.

The other hour of homework should be made up by reading and spelling practice 15-20 minutes at least times a week. Home reading should be recorded in children's reading records and signed. Reading records will be expected in on a Monday. In addition, once a fortnight children will be given 'talk homework'. This will be a topic to briefly discuss at home in preparation for a writing task the following day.

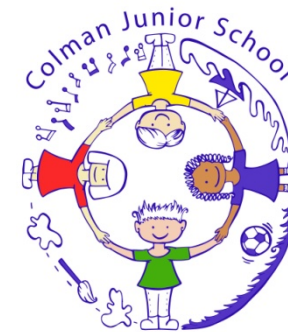
Curriculum Overview
