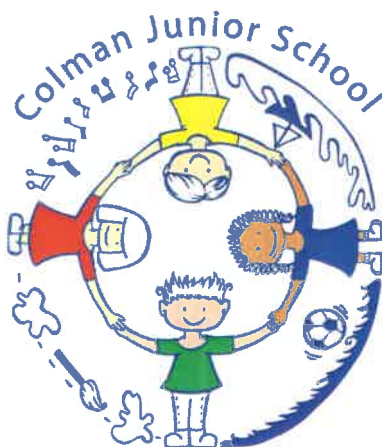

Dear Parents/Carers

Year 4 Roman Day

We have arranged for a visit to Norwich Castle Museum on Friday 28th September 2017, to support the study of this term's topic, *Invade, Invade, Invade!*

During the course of the day pupils will take part in a range of character-led living history activities, such as meeting Brutus (a Roman soldier) and meeting an Iceni tribeswoman to learn how to make jewellery. To add to the authenticity of the day, you may like your child to bring a Roman lunch; please find attached a letter with some suggestions for what to pack.

The cost of the day is £8.00, which includes the cost of coach hire. The visit will take place during normal school hours and therefore the school is unable to make a charge but is allowed to ask for voluntary contributions. No pupil will be excluded from the visit in the event of a contribution not being forthcoming but we do not have funds to meet the cost, so the visit can ONLY go ahead if sufficient voluntary contributions of £8.00 are received. Please contribute the full amount if at all possible. You may be aware that the school receives 'Pupil Premium' funding for pupils who are currently or have ever been eligible for free school meals. This enables us to pay the £8.00 contribution for those pupils. Please indicate on the reply slip if this is the case.

We will travel to and from the museum by coach. Pupils will need a packed lunch and a drink. Those children entitled to free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch from school. Please complete the slip attached and ask your child to return this to their Classroom Assistant by Wednesday 19th September.

A Day with the Romans and Iceni – Lunch Ideas!

Be Roman for the day!

Transform your packed lunch into a Roman Feast!

Things to include in your Roman lunch:

- Bread (granary is closest) with cheese (mozzarella is closest), meat (e.g. ham) or hard-boiled eggs
- Snacks such as sardines, dates, dried apricots, grapes, apples, carrots, nuts, raisins, olives
- Anything sweetened with honey – oat bars, sponge cakes made with honey etc. No sugar allowed!
- Fruit juice (they would not have had drinking water)

Things you must NOT include in your Roman lunch:

- Fizzy drinks
- Crisps
- Sweets
- Containers made of polythene, plastic or foil – instead, wrap your lunch in a brown paper bag or a cloth
